- Be applying to or enrolled in a post-secondary program of study on a full or part-time basis in the year after receiving the award.
- Demonstrate leadership or organizational ability at a school, university, business, or community level.
- Demonstrate a history of academic excellence.
- Demonstrate a commitment to community through a volunteer capacity to improve the quality of life for an individual or group.

Proof of acceptance/payment may be required to receive award payment.

Particular consideration will be given to greater Burlington area students with financial need, and to mature students who have overcome personal challenges in completing high school requirements.

- Provide a simple budget outlining your education program costs and funding sources.
