Scholarship/Award specifics: Rotary Club Burlington Lakeshore Student Awards are available annually through the Club. The Leap Forward Award is open to local youth or mature students to provide assistance for further training/education in a recognized occupation, vocation, or skilled trade. Applicants must demonstrate financial need and a strong desire to move forward.

Two awards of \$2,500 each are to be used for tuition/enrolment fees, program/trades supplies or training costs. These awards are intended to open new doors or provide an opportunity that would not otherwise have been available.

Closing date: Completed application form and supporting documents (as detailed below) must be submitted no later than May 1, 2023.

Applications will be screened by the Awards Sub Committee and final selection will be made through an interview process.

- Be a grade 12 graduate or mature student or equivalent.
- Be committed to pursuing post-secondary education, vocational training, skilled trades, or adult education with a specific career focus i.e. not general studies. (Student does not have to be entering their training/education immediately following graduation.)
- Demonstrate a reasonable level of past academic achievement.
- Demonstrate strength of character, honesty, diligence and reliability.
- Demonstrate financial need.

Proof of acceptance/payment may be required to receive award payment.

Particular consideration will be given to greater Burlington area students with financial need, and to mature students who have overcome personal challenges in completing high school requirements.
