

Vocational Studies Award 2024 Application Form

Scholarship/Award specifics: The Ron McDermott Vocational Studies Award is available annually through the Rotary Club Burlington Lakeshore Charitable Foundation.

One award of \$2,500 in memory of Ron McDermott is directed to a student pursuing post-secondary vocational training through a recognized institution or program such as a community college, private vocational school, university, apprenticeship, or trade program. The award is to be used for tuition/enrolment fees, program/trades supplies, or training costs.

This award is in memory of Ron McDermott, an active member of the Rotary Burlington Lakeshore and president in 1987-88. Ron believed in hard work, the value of professions and vocations, and the importance of education as one means of achieving higher vocational goals.

Closing date: Completed application form and supporting documents (as detailed below) must be submitted no later than May 1, 2024.

Applications will be screened by the Awards Sub Committee and final selection will be made through an interview process.

To be eligible, you must:

- Be a grade 12 graduate or mature student or equivalent.
- Be committed to pursuing vocational training / skilled trades training with a specific career focus (i.e. not general studies) in the year after receiving the award.
- Demonstrate a reasonable level of past academic achievement.
- Demonstrate strength of character, honesty, diligence and reliability.
- Demonstrate kindness through a volunteer capacity.

Proof of acceptance/payment may be required to receive award payment.

Particular consideration will be given to greater Burlington area students with financial need, and to mature students who have overcome personal challenges in completing high school requirements.
